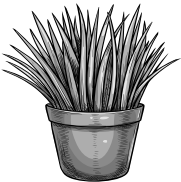
- **1788:** MARYLAND BECOMES THE SEVENTH STATE TO RATIFY THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.

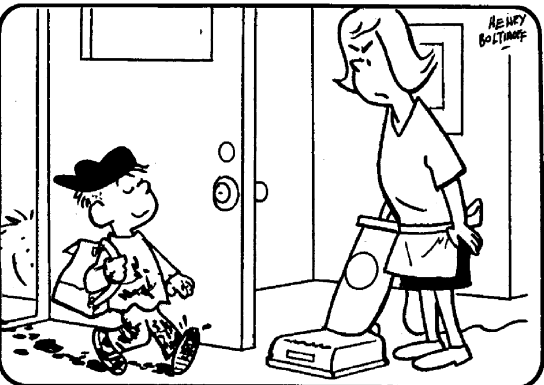

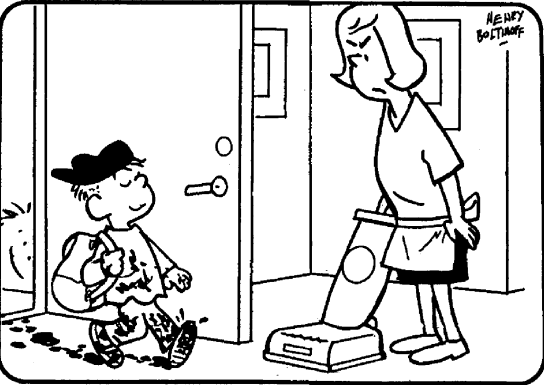

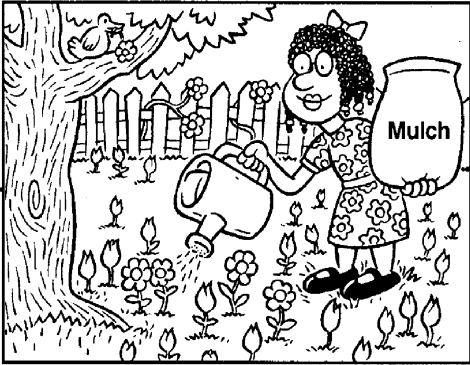

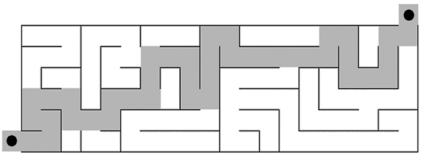
