DMV offers more services by appointment only

A limited selection of in-person services will now be available at 40 Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) offices across the state. Starting this past Monday, June 1, people can call to schedule a time most convenient to get their DMV business done. Appointments will begin today, June 3.

Services available by mail or online will not be available at field offices, but you can make an appointment for:

- Driver licensing and ID cards — originals, renewals and replacements, including passenger car and commercial licenses, and instruction permits
- Driver knowledge tests
- Driving privilege reinstatements
- Disabled parking placards
- VIN inspections for new-to-Oregon vehicles previously titled elsewhere
- Farm endorsements

If you need to renew a license or ID card, consider waiting until later in the summer when the initial demand for services may have subsided.

“Our first priority is the people who were unable to get the services we can do only in-person, such as replace a lost driver license or ID, issuing commercial driver licenses, knowledge tests and reinstating driving privileges,” DMV Ad-

ministrator Tom McClellan said. “Please be patient and expect longer than normal wait times on the phone and for an available appointment. “If you can wait to renew until later in the summer, please consider waiting so that appointments are available for those who need them most.”

People can make an appointment in the Florence area by calling the Florence DMV at 541-997-6837.

Offices have been equipped with plastic shields at each workstation, lobby furniture has been moved to promote social distancing, and extra cleaning of offices is scheduled to help keep customers and

employees safe. “When you do visit a DMV office, expect to follow safe social distancing and other measures in place for customers and employees,” McClellan said.

Enter the office for your appointment alone, unless a parent or guardian is needed to sign an application for a teenager applying for driving privileges or translator is needed for knowledge tests.

Community members are asked to cancel their appointment if they get ill, and reschedule if showing flu-like symptoms.

Florence Pregnancy and Parenting Center reopens

With specific coronavirus safety measures in place, the Florence Pregnancy and Parenting Center (PPC) is open again, offering pregnancy and/or parenting support and education. The PPC offers

free pregnancy tests and pregnancy options information, prenatal education, parenting education and life skills education. The PPC also has a Stork Boutique with diapers, baby and maternity

clothes, and other supplies. All services are free and confidential. The center, located at 1525 12th St., Suite G, is open Tuesdays and Thursdays, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m., or call 541-902-2273 for an appointment. The center’s weekly Fun Connections parent/child playgroup will remain closed until the program can safely resume.

Rent, utility assistance available from SOS fund

Siuslaw Outreach Services, through the support of community donations, private foundations, FEMA and Lane County Human Services Commission, has established a fund of \$118,000 to provide rent and utility assistance to households that

have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic and Governor Brown’s executive order. Nearly half of the funds come from Lane County Commissioners and the Human Services Commission. Including donations from community
