While the majority of troops involved in the invasion were from America and Britain, troops from many other countries participated in D-Day and the Battle of Normandy, including Australia, Belgium, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, France, Greece, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway and Poland.

Americans were at the heart of Operation Neptune's multi-pronged amphibious assault on the coastline in order to reestablish a military foothold on the continent with the goal of eventually defeating Hitler's forces and retaking

The scale of the firepower employed that day was un-

precedented and included sorties flown by 3,000 aircraft of assorted types and nearly 7,000 vessels which participated in naval operations. More than 150,000 Allied troops were directly

on D-Day resulted in more in that process. than 10,000 Allied casualties, with almost 5,000 of those soldiers dying. German casualties were estimated to be triple those

As part of an overall Allied strategy to free Europe from fascism, British Prime Minister Winston Churchill, American General Dwight D. 




