FAQs about the Siuslaw Public Library in Florence & Mapleton

Is the library open?

The Siuslaw Public Library is open for phone calls, emails, item return, and curbside pickup of requested items at the Florence branch. At this time, the library is not open to the public.

Can I return items?

The library accepting the return of library materials in the west/Maple St parking lot of the Florence location Monday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and on Fridays from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. We are using large bins that will allow us to quarantine items for 72 hours for the safety of patrons and staff.

What if I want to check out an item, but I don't know what I want?

Give the library a call from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Monday through Friday

and let us know what kind of books or DVDs you enjoy. Staff would love to pull a few titles just for you!

Can I email my requests for curbside pickup?

Right now, staff are limiting requests for new items to phone calls. We need to make sure we a workable system and that staff can keep up with demand before expanding to other request types. The library thanks you for your patience! The exception to this system is that people are still able to place holds through the online catalog for items that are checked out to another patron.

Can I access the internet?

Although the public internet computers are not currently available for use, the library does have wireless internet access available

from the parking lot at both locations. Signs posted in both locations give all the details.

Can I reserve a meeting or study room?

The library is not currently open to the public, and we cannot accept reservations for any of our meeting rooms.

Are you accepting donations of used books, DVDs, and CDs?

The Friends of the Library are not currently accepting donations, but they

will send out a community-wide update as soon as they are able to accept materials again. Thank you for your support!
