City to begin Chip Seal pavement project Monday

The 2020 pavement ("chips"). preservation project for this summer will be the application of a hot oil, chip and fog seal along Kingwood Street, from 10th to 35th streets.

Chip sealing operations will begin this Monday, July 13 (weathpermitting) and will continue through Thursday, July 16.

Chip Sealing is a common pavement maintenance practice that extends pavement life and provides a good driving surface. With chip seals, a thin film of heated asphalt liquid is sprayed on the road surface, followed by the placement of small aggregates

The chips are compacted to orient them for maximum adherence to the asphalt, and excess stone is swept from the surface.

A fog seal is then applied to further bind the chips to the asphalt liquid, protect the chip seal from UV rays and finish the road preservation.

The City has completed five other chip seal projects in recent years. Previous projects included Oak Street between 20th and 35th streets; Rhododendron Drive between 35th and Sebastian streets; 35th Street between Pine and for the bicyclists and pe-Siano Loop; Oak Street destrians.

In addition, Micro- plication. Coat will be applied to bike lanes along Kingwood Street within the project area. MicroCoat is a micro seal coating system that will protect the bike lanes from degradation.

MicroCoat was custom designed at a stateof-the-art laboratory in Portland Ore., specifically for the Pacific Northwest. It will provide a smoother surface 997-4106.

As with any street construction project, there will be slight delays during the chip and fog seal application along with the MicroCoat ap-

Residents and businesses are advised to use alternate routes to avoid the work area between July 13–16. For those who need to

travel in those corridors, slow down and be patient and attentive to the traffic control flaggers.
