## City to begin Chip Seal pavement project Monday

The 2020 pavement (“chips”) preservation project for this summer will be the application of a hot oil, chip and fog seal along Kingwood Street, from 10th to 35th streets.

Chip sealing operations will begin this Monday, July 13 (weather permitting) and will continue through Thursday, July 16.

Chip Sealing is a common pavement maintenance practice that extends pavement life and provides a good driving surface. With chip seals, a thin film of heated asphalt liquid is sprayed on the road surface, followed by the placement of small aggregates

between 35th and 46th streets; Spruce Street between 25th and 35th streets; and 42nd Street from Hwy 101 to Spruce Street.

In addition, MicroCoat will be applied to bike lanes along Kingwood Street within the project area. MicroCoat is a micro seal coating system that will protect the bike lanes from degradation.

MicroCoat was custom designed at a state-of-the-art laboratory in Portland Ore., specifically for the Pacific Northwest. It will provide a smoother surface for the bicyclists and pedestrians.

As with any street construction project, there will be slight delays during the chip and fog seal application along with the MicroCoat application.

Residents and businesses are advised to use alternate routes to avoid the work area between July 13–16.

For those who need to travel in those corridors, slow down and be patient and attentive to the traffic control flaggers.

## COVID-19 STATS

### State and County COVID counts

#### Lane County Public Health (LCPH) —

Lane County Public Health (LCPH) was notified of 13 additional positive cases of COVID-19 and two new Long Term Care worker cases. This makes a total of 284 positive tests. (Note: The total includes confirmed and presumptive.)

- Deaths: 3
- Infectious: 75
- Sick at home: 180
- Recovered: 60
- 27,961 (total individuals tested)

#### Oregon Health Authority (OHA) — (As of July 10)

COVID-19 has claimed six more lives in Oregon, raising the state’s death toll to 232. The OHA reported 389 newly confirmed and presumptive cases of COVID-19 today, the highest single-day report of confirmed cases in Oregon since the start of the pandemic. Total number of cases as of Friday was 11,454.

The new cases reported today are in the following counties: Baker (1), Benton (6), Clackamas (11), Crook (1), Deschutes (8), Douglas (2), Hood River (4), Jackson (9), Jefferson (15), Josephine (2), Lane (10), Linn (3), Malheur (21), Marion (28), Morrow (3), Multnomah (37), Polk (3), Tillamook (1), Umatilla (51), Union (1), Wallowa (1), Wasco (5), Washington (44), Yamhill (8).
