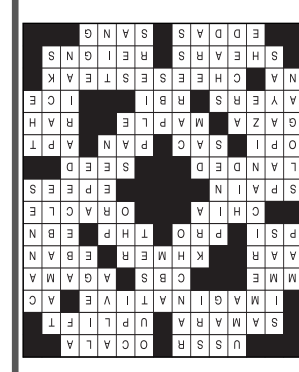
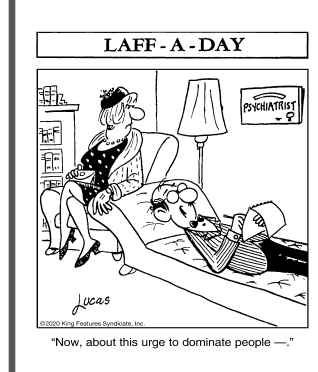


The Garden Bug

This plant is one of the easiest to care for. Once they bloom, keep the soil slightly moist. If blooms are very large and the stem begins to bend, stake the stem for support until the flowers are spent. Cut off any spent flowers and stalks, but allow the leaves to remain until they yellow and begin to die. This will help fuel the bulb for the next year's blooming season. In fall, trim away any growth left, leaving the bulb in the ground. Mulch over the bulb with organic bark mulch. In spring, pull away the mulch when you see green sprouts.
