OSHA offers online reporting for COVID-19 non-compliance

As Oregon Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) continues to process and evaluate complaints related to COVID-19, the division encourages workers and members of the public to use its online workplace hazard reporting form at osha.osregon.gov/workers/Pages/index.aspx.

While people may still call the division with complaints, the online reporting form offers a quicker way to bring concerns to the division's attention.

"We will continue to take phone calls about workplace hazards concerning the novel coronavirus," said Michael Wood, administrator for Oregon OSHA. "Howev-

er, our online system is just as fast -- if not faster -- at absorbing complaints and allowing us to efficiently respond to them."

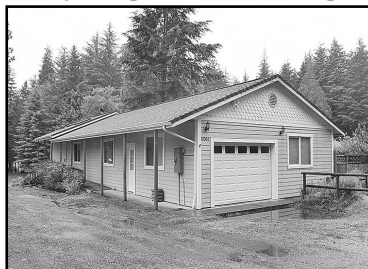
