Siuslaw School District provides fall food services to families

As the school year begins in Comprehensive Distance Learning on Wednesday, the Siuslaw School District will resume food service operations in the community to assist students and their families next week.

The schedule will be very similar to last spring. Twelve buses will go out into the community, most making two stops each. The mobile delivery stops are timed so that students can get to a stop just after the end of their last class of primary instruction or to be able to grab their meal before returning for applied learning time in the afternoon. There will also be three fixed stations, one at each of the school buildings.

With school attendance being virtual for the foreseeable future, this schedule will also accommodate food services for students in the transition to limited in-person and hybrid instruction when the metrics allow.

Food services will be available on certain non-attendance days for students:

- 10-9 - Statewide Inservice
- 10-15 - Family Conference Day
- 10-16 - Family Conference Day
- 11-13 - Quarter 1 Inservice
- 12-21 - Vacation Day 1
