In January 2020, the FB4K board realized the necessity for a Transit Cargo Van to continue the program. We purchased a used van from Johnston Motors with the support of Cross Road Assembly of God, Florence Kiwanis, Western Lane Community Foundation, Chambers Family Foundation, Mapleton Community Foundation, Oregon Pacific Bank, PeaceHealth Peace Harbor Medical Foundation, Windermere Realty and Presbyterian Church.

In 2018 & 2019 FB4K launched successful \$40,000.00 Matching Funds Campaigns. Core Donors were Oregon Pacific Bank, Peace Harbor Hospital, River Roasters, David & Linda Lauck Trust, Florence Kiwanis, Western Lane Community Foundation and one Anonymous Donor. In 2018's Campaign our community members contributed a total of \$40,509.00 to match our generous Core Donors!
