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## Even Exchange by Donna Pettman

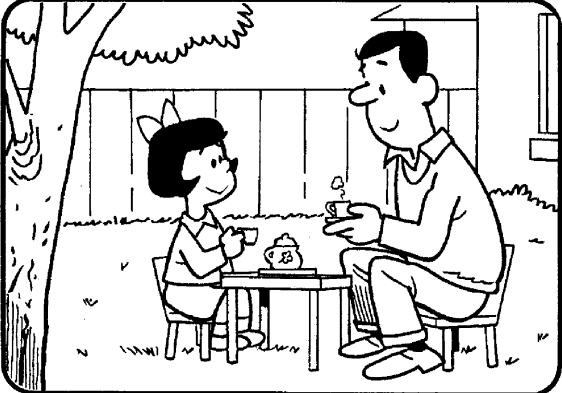

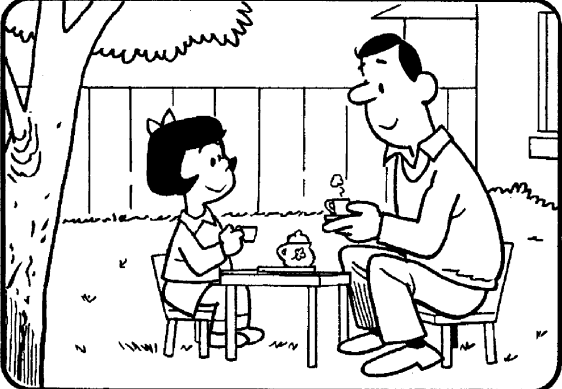

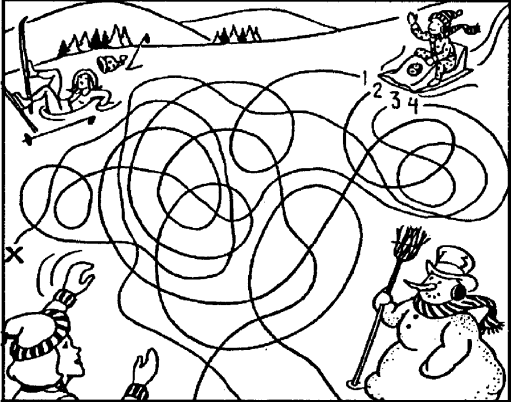

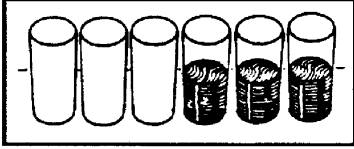
**SNOW GO!** Which path does our snowmobiler pal take to reach point X below? Choose route 1, 2, 3 or 4.

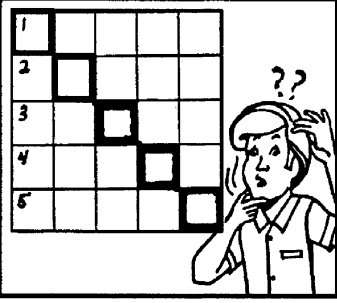
How is it done?

PENCIL IN words in accord with definitions below to form the name of a European country diagonally.

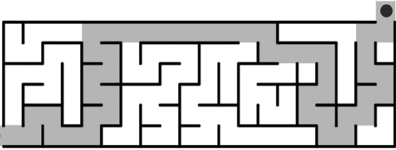

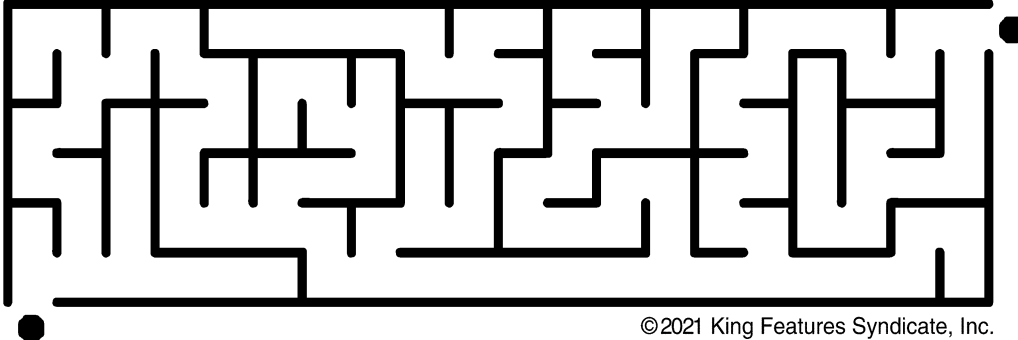
