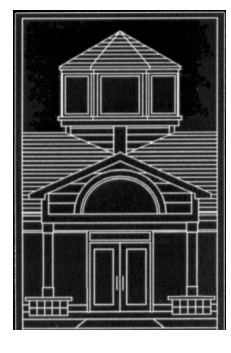

## City Lights to reignite the lights this Friday

City Lights Cinemas, 1930 Highway 101, will reopen its doors to the public on Friday, March 5, with Disney's highly anticipated family film "Raya and the Last Dragon" leading the marquee.

The safety of patrons and staff remain the theater's our No. 1 priority, according to Education Director Jared Anderson.

"That means all moviegoers should don their favorite and most comfortable masks before entering the business," he said. "Concession purchases are encouraged, yet we ask patrons to keep their masks on while watching a film when not eating or drinking for prolonged periods if other parties are present."

On the reopening slate is "Nomadland," this year's best-reviewed film and a shoo-in for multiple Oscar nominations, including for Frances McDormand's revelatory lead performance as a woman who loses everything

and journeys through the American West to find herself.

City Lights is also set to feature "Chaos Walking," a science fiction thriller starring Tom Holland, Mads Mikelsen and Daisy Ridley, about a dystopian future where there are no women — and all living creatures can hear each other's thoughts.

Alex Grady, Director of Operations, "the man in the butter suit" during Curbside Concession, said City Lights would maintain those popcorn popping evenings due to popular demand.

Curbside Concessions will continue Friday and Saturday nights from 4 to 7 p.m. Operations resume for in-person moviegoing with strict limits on audience size on March 5. Advance tickets are recommended.
