OBITUARY

TEMPLE—Charles (Chuck) Frances Temple, loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather, passed away March 3, 2021, at the age of 98.

Chuck was born in North Platte, Neb., to Charles Francis Temple and Jenny Grace (Beeler) Temple, the youngest of seven children. He grew up in Bellflower, Calif., and graduated from Excelsior High School in 1940.

At age 20, Chuck became a Marine Corps fighter pilot during World War II, joining shortly after the attack on Pearl Harbor. He was severely wounded during the Battle of Okinawa, when his Hellcat crashed on takeoff during an enemy bombing raid.

Chuck spent several years in hospitals recuperating from his injuries. He returned to flying and finally left the Marine Corps in 1949 to attend

On July 8, 1950 he married Mary Jane Jordan in Los Angeles, Calif. They raised five children: Mary, Charles, James, Gerald and Joan. They were married for 32 years, until Mary's passing in 1982.

He attended the University of California Santa Barbara, graduating in 1952 with a degree in Industrial Engineering.

'Following college, he taught school and, later, was a successful industrial and magnetics engineer in the aerospace industry of Southern California.

In 1960, he moved his family to Eugene, Ore., to join his two older brothers, Joeseph and Bernard, in the cabinet business. He and his brothers ran Temple Counter Tops for 31 years.

with his home woodshop, creating masterpieces for many. He was an active member of the Lion's club, Kiwanis and Elks clubs. His favorite morning activity was joining the daily coffee club at the Florence Airport, with several of his friends, until he moved back to Eugene in

For the last two-and-ahalf years, Chuck lived independently at the Springs at Greer Gardens, making many new friends, and was part of the Veterans Club there.

He is preceded in death by his parents, his six siblings, and his wife Mary.

He is survived by his children: Joann McPherson (Victor McPherson), Mary Temple Bosak (Robert Bosak), Charles Temple (Judy Temple), James Temple (Colleen Temple), Jerry Temple (Gloria Temple), Joan Temple McIntyre (Brooks McIntyre), and Stephanie Rasor Milner (Kevin Milner), along with his 15 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.



PeaceHealth eases hospital visitation restrictions

With COVID-19 transmission falling in Lane County, PeaceHealth has eased its temporary "no-visitor" policy at all four Oregon hospitals to allow one visitor per day, per patient, with some limited exceptions.

For patients suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19, the no-visitor policy remains, with limited exceptions.

This change applies to PeaceHealth Sacred Heart Medical Center at River-Bend; PeaceHealth Sacred Heart Medical Center, University District; Peace-Health Cottage Grove Community Medical Center; and PeaceHealth Peace Harbor Medical Center.

PeaceHealth Medical Group clinics will continue to limit visitors to only those accompanying patients needing assistance.

The change in hospital visitation aims to balance safety with patient, caregiver and visitor well-being and satisfaction. Peace-Health will continue to diligently monitor the local prevalence of COVID-19 and will tighten these rules again if necessary, as the health and safety of caregivers, patients and community remains the top priority.

While most patients will be allowed only one designated visitor per day, two may be allowed for patients at end-of-life as well as minors, including infants in the Neonatal Intensive Care ity, in alignment with the them as a visitor. While Unit. Patients with disabilthree support persons.

Any exceptions to the policy will be made at the mometers available discretion of PeaceHealth clinical care leader-ship.

Also effective now, PeaceHealth will no longer actively take the temperature of caregivers and visitors upon entry to any PeaceHealth Oregon facil-

Centers for Disease Control ities may be allowed up to and Prevention infection prevention recommenda-

> However, anyone entering a PeaceHealth facility will still be asked to confirm that they do not have a fever or other common symptoms of COVID-19.

There will still be therscreening stations for those who request a check.

Visitors must wear a mask at all times and will be asked to limit their movement throughout the hospitals. They will be issued a dated bracelet identifying
