The referees called an Exceptional Substitution in order to allow game-play to continue. Another issue for the Sailors was that they only had one sub to begin with, so losing a player meant they would have to finish that set and the remainder of the match with no

subs. Dooley discussed why losing Jensen early on in the match was particularly difficult that night. "We don't end up with six players often, and both of the people that we've trained for setting — Summer [Flansberg] had gotten a concussion in the last game, so she was out, and [tonight] Briena got injured," said

Dooley. "So, none of the other players could really focus in on setting. Despite everything, they handled that well and kept playing." The Sailors kept pushing but ended up losing the first set 14-25. In the second set, the girls adjusted as best they could to not having their usual setter. "Some of them were

doing new things that they've never done before," Dooley said. "And for the first time in a game, that's really tough." Wierichs had two aces in the set, which definitely helped the Sailors keep up. However, they struggled to gain momentum and finished the second set with another 14-25 loss. In the third set, Ste-

vens had an ace and a clutch dig. The girls kept battling but, with no subs, fatigue began to play a factor as the Cougars went on to win the match, 25-9. Notably, freshman Kylee Carson had two kills for the evening, a personal best. Mapleton next played Crow for a rematch on the road Thursday (April

1), with the Cougars once again winning in three sets. Freshman Kylee Carson had 2 aces, junior Jahala Blake had 2 kills, and senior Emily Stevens had 1 block. Mapleton's final league game will be Tuesday (April 6) at home against Eddyville Charter, beginning at 6 p.m.

majority of the catch now and typically peak in March. *Reminder:* The popular winter steelhead bank fishery around the Alsea Hatchery remains open but the hatchery grounds are closed to the public. Anglers are required to park in designated parking lot to access the river. **SALMON RIVER:** Winter steelhead are around in the Salmon

River. The peak for winter steelhead on the Salmon River is typically January to March. *Note:* The Salmon River hatchery remains closed to walk in anglers. Anglers can use access points upstream and downstream of the hatchery to access those traditional fishing locations. **SILETZ RIVER:** Winter steelhead fishing on the Siletz River has slowed down again as the river drops and clears. The drift boat anglers are catching

some fish down low in the system but it continues to be a slow year on the Siletz and all coastal rivers. Fresh fish will continue to enter the system through March despite the low and clear conditions. Fish are now distributed throughout the river from the boat sections up through the gorge. Mid-February to mid-March is typically the peak for Siletz steelheading. The 4-mile bridge (aka Steel Bridge) in the Siletz gorge is open to motorized vehicles on the weekends only. Anglers can walk/bike in the road during the weekdays. There is a parking area located at the 1-mile gate where anglers can walk/bike upstream from there. **WILSON RIVER:** Steelhead fishing on the Wilson has been slow to fair this season; there have been some really good days, but the past week has really dropped off.
