## Siuslaw Pioneer Museum reopens with new hours

The Siuslaw Pioneer Museum in Florence's Historic District has re-opened after a long closure due to the pandemic.

New hours are Thursday through Sunday, from noon to 4 p.m.

Although the museum was closed to visitors, volunteers continued their work of preserving Flor-

ence's history. Four volunteers in particular — Sandy Zinn, Sharon Waite, Dixie Buss and Hester Goode, — have been busy in the Research Library putting all the artifacts on a new data base and labeling all of them.

They have completed the logging section and will continue until all sections

are done.

In addition, Duke and Tricia Wells of Old Cedar Tree Woodworking provided "cookies," which are rounds of lumber, to display the various log branding irons used to brand logs and show the different branding irons used.

Visitors will now be able to see how each artifact was

used by local pioneers.

Waite has been working on an exhibit of the 1922 Lane County Fair. It was open before the shutdown, but has been held over for those who were unable to view it. The museum is located at 268 Maple Street in the old schoolhouse.

## Lane County seeks responses to Hunger Factors survey

FOOD for Lane County (FFLC) is conducting a survey to better understand who, why and where the community is in need of food assistance.

The confidential survey is open to anyone who has witnessed or experienced food insecurity and is available from April 1 to April 30.

The survey is confidential and should take 10 to 15 minutes. People have the option of entering a drawing for one of 20 \$25 gift cards to thank them for their time.

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, even as the economy improved, Lane County residents continued to access food assistance at the highest rate in several years. FFLC anticipates that hunger and food insecurity will persist even after the economy recovers, thus making participation in this survey crucial.

"The Hunger Factors survey is one of the important ways we get feed-

back from those in our community who are experiencing food insecurity," said FFLC Executive Director Tom Mulhern. "The more we know about the attitudes and life situations of those who need assistance, the better we and our food distribution partners will be able to respond with compassion, inclusion and meaningful impact."

The online community survey is modeled after the Hunger Factors survey that has been implemented since 1986 through Oregon Food Bank. The survey can be accessed through links on FFLC's website, social media, email distributions and newsletters, and through the use of QR codes that will be printed and given out with food distribution efforts at FFLC partner agencies.

"We need your input to understand how we can best collaborate with our partners and our community to get food to people's

tables," Mulhern said.

FFLC's survey is intended for anyone who has had to make choices between food and other resources. It's for anyone who has experienced hunger or has worried about their next meal. It is for anyone who has visited a pantry, a meal site or gotten help with food.

It is for anyone who knows someone else that is making tough choices because of food insecurity.

"By completing this survey, you will help us create access to food for all across Lane County," Mulhern said.

FOOD For Lane County's mission is to reduce hunger by engaging the community to access food. The program does that through the lens of its values: compassion, inclusion and collaboration.

The program distributes more than 8 million pounds of (mostly donated) food through a network of 164 partner agencies across Lane County.


