## The Garden Bug

### Flowering Ground Covers

Landscapers love these plants, as they offer beauty and function, giving a yard color while helping to fight weeds and control erosion. Some favorites for full sun areas are Creeping Phlox (*Phlox subulata*), Candytuft (*Iberis sempervirens*), Ice Plant (*Delosperma cooperi*), Yellow Alyssum (*Aurinia saxatilis*), Dragon's Blood (*Sedum spurium*) and Snow-in-Summer (*Cerastium tomentosum*). Some shade-tolerating varieties are Pachysandra (*Pachysandra terminalis*), Bugleweed (*Ajuga reptans*), Yellow Archangel (*Lamium galeobdolon*), Cotoneaster (*Cotoneaster horizontalis*) and Sweet Woodruff (*Galium odoratum*). - Brenda Weaver
