Team unity may be affected if there is a huge gap in the compensation of players. Where is the money to pay these athletes coming from? It is most likely coming from television contracts, gate receipts, team-related souvenirs and alumni gifts.

The dollars generated by

these two sports help fund non-revenue sports offered at NCAA universities. Last year, we saw the effects on schools when the NCAA tournaments were cancelled. Schools dropped many non-revenue sports as a way to cut costs. They had to drop an equal number of men’s and women’s sports.

This law will trickle

down to all levels of sports. The effects on individuals may cause them to alter dreams and goals. Athletes and extracurricular students wishing to continue their interests during their college days may see those activities no longer available.

We might just see only those sports currently being played at the profes-

sional level.

These sports only comprise a small percentage of the total sports world. Just last year, we witnessed the first scholarships awarded by universities for competitive gaming students. Unfortunately, the last scholarships formed may be the first eliminated.

While writing this piece, there have been two ma-

jor changes in the college sports world. In Oregon, the legislature voted to allow college athletes to be compensated for the use of their likenesses. Also, then the NCAA decided to allow athletes to transfer without having to sit out a year at their new school of choice. I will be discussing these ramifications of these changes in the future.

and peak in January and February. Lake Creek closed to all fishing on March 31 and will open on May 22 for trout fishing.

ALSEA RIVER: *Winter steelhead*

Winter steelhead fishing continues to be slow on the Alsea. The recent rain improved the conditions and the fishing picked up a bit. Overall, it continues to be slow and the run is winding down for the year as we head into April. Although it has

been a slow year there are still fish to be caught in the system through the month of March. The Alsea River remains open to steelhead fishing through April and then closes on April 30. Trout fishing in streams opens on May 22. The later returning wild broodstock fish are providing the majority of the catch now and typically peak in February and March.

SALMON RIVER: *Winter steelhead*

Winter steelhead fishing closes on the Salmon River on March 31. Trout fishing in streams will open on

May 22. The peak for winter steelhead on the Salmon River is typically January to March. Last updated 3/31/21.

**NOTE:** Reminder, the Salmon River hatchery remains closed to walk in anglers. Anglers can use access points upstream and downstream of the hatchery to access those traditional fishing locations.

SILETZ RIVER: *Winter steelhead*

Steelhead fishing on the Siletz River improved last week with the bump in river levels but has slowed down now with the low and clear conditions. The Siletz River remains open year-round for steelhead fishing and provides opportunity through April for winter steelhead and then summer steelhead typically start to show up in decent numbers in May. Fish are now distributed throughout the river from the boat sections up through the gorge. Mid-February to mid-March is typically the peak for Siletz winter steelheading.
