On Friday (April 30), the Vikings hosted the Sky-Em League Showcase at home, competing against Marshfield, Cottage Grove, Junction City and Elmira. Adding several more Personal Records (PRs) and winning times to the season, the boys finished in first place overall with 194.5 points, and the girls finished fourth with 94 points.

The boys' team won several events that afternoon. On the track, James Smith won the 400 meters with a time of 55.70a,
