their game finish early, but after five innings. On offense, the team struggled to connect with the ball and get on base, scoring only 1 run in the fourth inning as a result of Beau Erickson skillfully stealing three bases after being walked.

"In the fourth inning, the guys that came to the plate showed a lot of plate discipline, worked several walks and pushed a run across," said Shinn.

On defense, Clay Kramer and Jason Garcia each had two strikeouts for the evening, and Erickson picked up one as well.

"Marist is a very good baseball team," admitted Shinn. "Their pitcher, Starr, did a great job of

attacking the zone."
