Then they simply tag their bags, fill them with empty Oregon 10-cent refund containers, and drop them off at the new BottleDrop network drop location. Their containers are counted and credited to their accounts within seven days.

BottleDrop is operated by the Oregon Beverage Recycling Cooperative (OBRC), which introduced the Green




