On May 22, Florence Golf Links was the scene for the 11th annual Siuslaw Open Benefit Golf Tournament presented by Oregon Pacific Bank, Florence Dental Clinic, Peace Health, Mehlum Family Foundation, and Banner Bank to benefit Siuslaw Outreach Services

Eighty-eight golfers, 18 volunteers and 35 sponsors converged onto the Scottish-style course to raise just over \$13,000 toward programs and resources to benefit victims of domestic violence, sexual violence, human trafficking and homelessness.

According to SOS Executive Director Bob Teter, it was a record-breaking year in a number of ways, including the number of participants and sponsors, as well as the amount raised.




Teter added, "This success of this event will help us help many families who are struggling."
