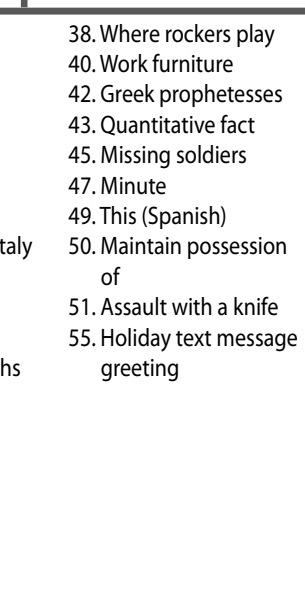
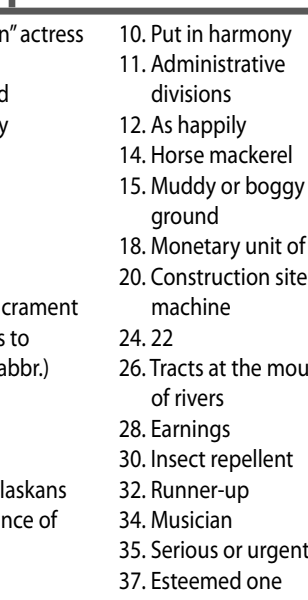


The Garden Bug
