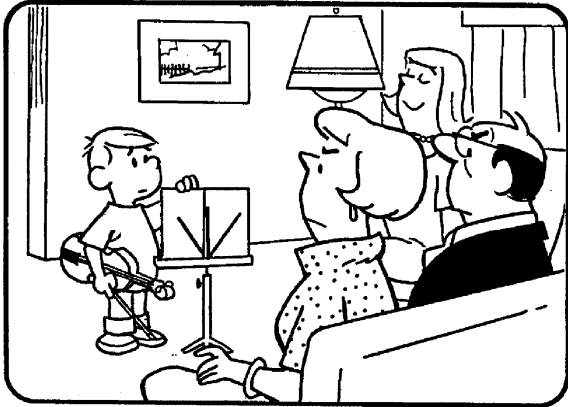

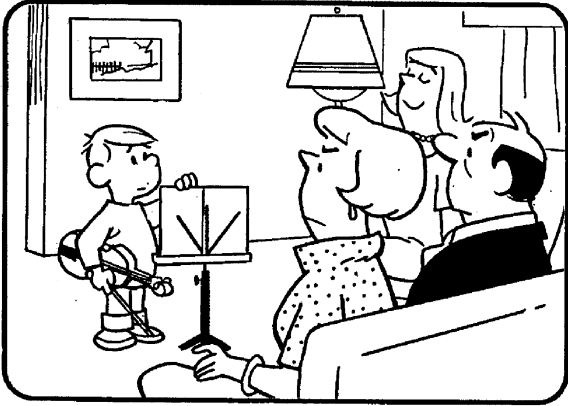

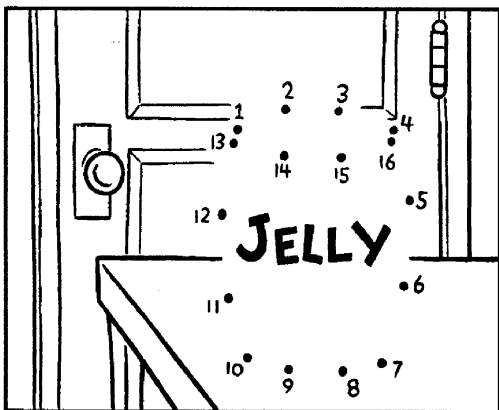


Find at least six differences in details between panels.

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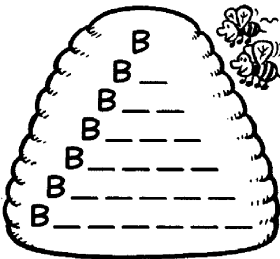


CONNECT THE DOTS and find out when a door is not a door.

- 7) Having two feet.

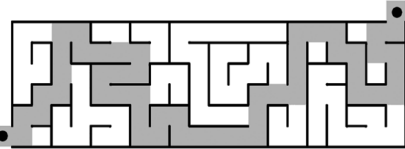

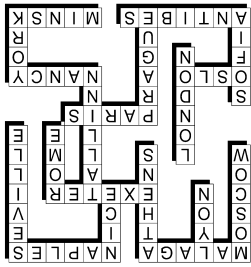

5. Raft, rant, rang, ring, wing.

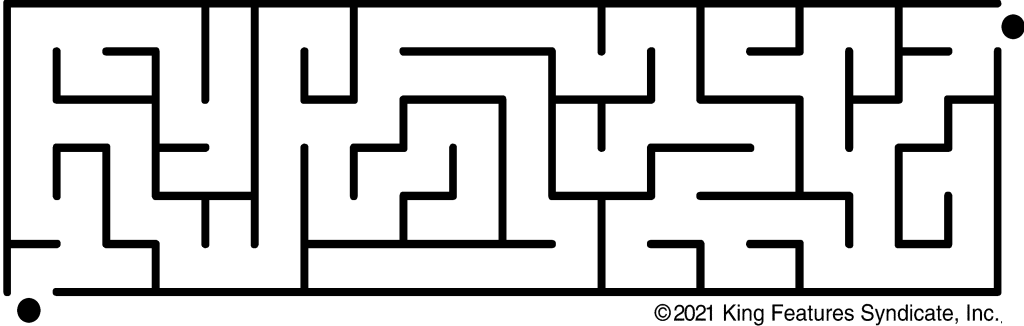


Kids' Maze Solution

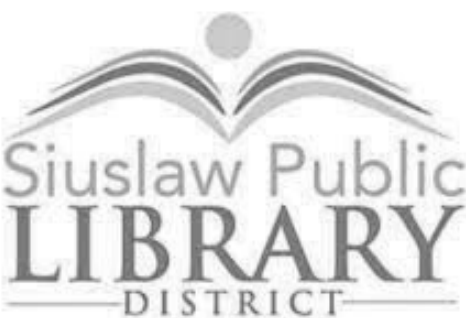
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
