ing on Wednesday, Aug. 18, to hear a fascinating account by Siuslaw Genealogy Society vice president, Rick Norwood.

As a retired archaeologist, learning about an excavation of the homesite of his ninth great grandparents immediately piqued his interest.

Robert Waterman and Elizabeth Bourne landed in Salem, Mass., from England in 1636. Soon thereafter, they relocated to Marshfield, Mass., in Plymouth Colony, and built a house. Their small starter home

ground and palisaded wall American construction. It burned down in a catastrophic fire after a short period of occupation. House fires were common in these early times.


"In archaeology, we find that while fire destroys, it also preserves certain items," Norwood said. "The excavation and study of the Waterman house ruins is one of the few remaining early period Plymouth Colony homes. It was possible to reconstruct the diet, see expressions of gender roles, environmental adaptation,

cultural exchange. It was also possible to reconstruct the architecture and material culture of the Waterman family home. Archaeology can reveal ordinary day to day life of people not always recorded in the written record."

This will be an amazing opportunity to learn more about early American life.


