Amateurs and professionals alike are encouraged to enter. Portrait-oriented photos stand the best chance of being used in print media, though landscape-oriented photos are equally encouraged.

Ideal photos will be in .jpg format, color, and measure 1920x1080 pixels and 8MP, if possible.

By entering the contest, contestants state they have ownership

and rights to submit the photo, that the photo is free of encumbrance by other entities, and give the chamber unlimited rights for the use of photos in its publicity and marketing materials. Entrants do not give up rights for future use of the photos for their own private use.

Entrants must provide signed waivers (photo release forms) granting the Chamber permission to use the image or likeness of anyone included in the photo. Photos selected for use must not have watermarks and will require a signed release by the photographer and any recognizable persons in the photo. Entrants under the age of 18 must have written permission of a parent or guardian.

A free drive through vaccination clinic will be held on Saturday, Aug. 21, from 1 to 3 p.m. at Siuslaw Middle School, 2525 Oak St. in Florence. Walk-up vaccinations will also be available.

Insurance is not needed. The clinic will be offering the Pfizer vaccine for ages 12 and older, and the Johnson & Johnson vaccine for ages 18 and older.

Lane County Public Health is offering a \$50 Visa card to anyone over the age of 12 receiving the vaccination at this clinic; this is a limited time incentive while supplies last. The \$50 will be issued in the form of a Visa card at the time of vaccination that can be used anywhere that accepts Visa. Participants will receive \$50 per dose (1 card for the first dose, 1 card for the second dose).
