Group to 'March on Washington' in support of 'For the People' Act

On Saturday, Aug. 28, from 1 to 2 p.m., community members are invited to stop by the corners of Highway 101 and Highway 126 in Florence for a March on Washington in support of the "For the People" Act, Florence Indivisible is hosting a rally to send a clear message to Congress that they must deliver for the American people and pass the "For the People" Act before it's too late. This rally follows previous rallies held in Florence, including "Demand Democracy" on July 24 and "Democracy Can't Wait" on Aug. 10. This is in addition to additional rallies held on

weekends to bring attention to the need for the U.S. Congress "to step up, do their job, and pass the act," organizers said.

The day itself has a historical significance because on Aug. 28, 1963, 58 years ago, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., led 250,000 people on a historic March On Washington.

In front of the Lincoln Memorial, Dr. King delivered his famous "I Have a Dream" speech, calling on the nation to rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed. His speech that day has become one of the defining moments in American history.

The rally will take place from 1 to 2 p.m. on the corners of Highway 101 and Highway 126, but of another group is at this location, the rally will move to the alternate location at Florence City Hall on Highway 101.
