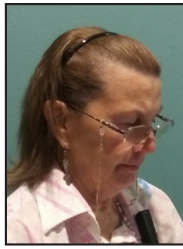
OBITUARIES

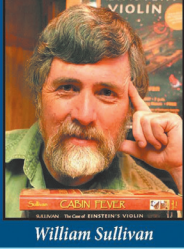
