It was determined the bills were estimated since arrangements are possible, March 2021.

Staffing issues prevented an in-person meter reader. When meters were actually read last March, many customers' estimated usage was significantly lower than their actual usage.

This caused an outcry by locals who weren't financially prepared for such high water bills.

On Tuesday, the MWD board decided, by vote, that the following would be the policy going forward:

A 50% credit will be given to the month of February billing amount. This does not include amounts that were past due prior to February 2021.


