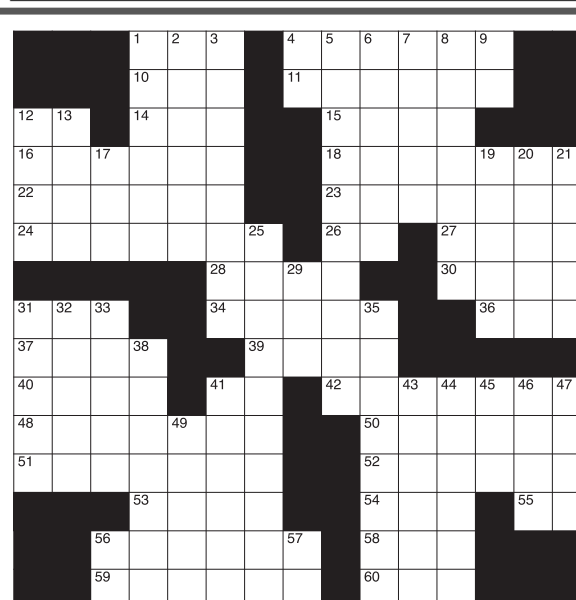
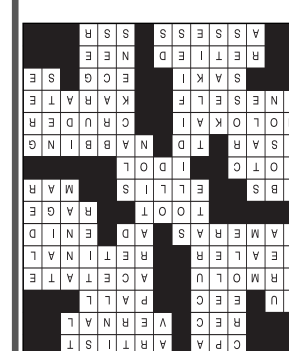
The Garden Bug
