SMITH—Harriet G. Presbyterian Church in Darien, Conn., and the Little Church on the Prairie in Lake-wood, Wash., and as the direc-tor of the Valley Presbyterian Day School in Scotts-dale, Ariz.

In 1983, she and her husband represented the Presbyterian Church USA to the General Assem-bly of the Church of Scotland.

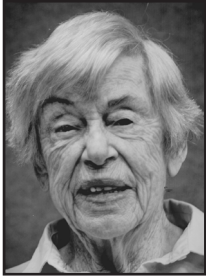
She also served on the denomination's Advisory Council on Discipleship and Worship and wrote Vac-ation Bible School curricu-lum for Westminster Press.

Harriet was born in Cham-bersburg, Penn., on Jan. 18, 1923, the daughter of Harold G. and Ruth (née Mc-Curdy) Van Riper.

She graduated from Car-lisle High School and Penn State University. At Penn State, she was elected to the Cwens, a Penn State honor society, was president of the Christian Association and was active in the Westmin-ster Foundation. She then spent a year as an intern with the Presbyterian Board of Christian Education be-fore earning a master's de-gree from Yale Universi-ty.

On June 11, 1949, Harriet married Richard K. Smith, a fellow Yale student from Cottage Groove, Ore., in Carlisle, Penn. The couple moved to Ephrata, Wash., in 1950, where she start-ed a community nursery school. Their children, Kirk and Paul, were born there.

In her life, Harriet served as Director of Christian Education at the Noroton

Harriet also participated in a Presby-terian Wom-en's Asian Encounter meet-ing with women from four Asian countries to discuss women's issues. Harriet was elected as the first woman moderator of the Presbytery of the Grand Canyon.

For over 40 years, Harriet was also known as "Happy Feet" the clown. Combin-ing her interests in humor and modern dance, she was a "fool for Christ" to groups from Connecticut to Pan-ama, from Arizona to Ore-gon.

She was a member and elder of the Presbyterian Church of the Siuslaw and Chapter DY of PEO.

Harriet is survived by her husband and their two sons and their spouses: Bishop Kirk and Laura Smith of Phoenix, Ariz., and the Rev. Paul and Laura Smith, of Watontown, Penn. There are three grandchildren: Sean Smith of San Jose, Cal-if., and Jordan Smith and Nathaniel Smith of New York City.

Burns's Riverside Chapel will be handling arrange-ments.

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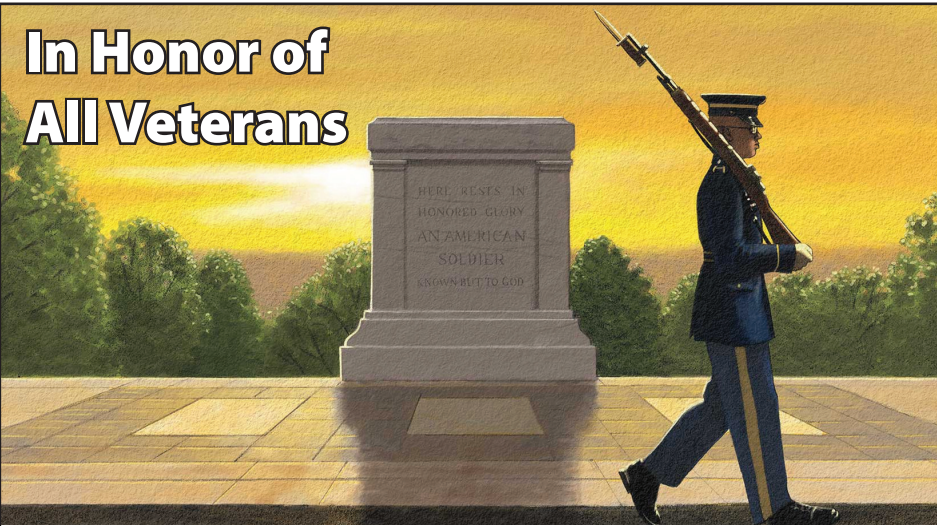
