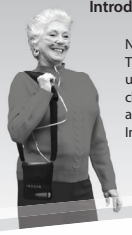
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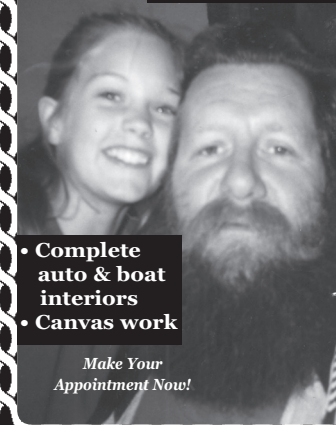

Sign up for Fill Your Pantry from Oct. 25 to Nov. 1

Florence residents can once again fill their pantries for the coming season by ordering online at the Florence Farmers Market website, www.florencefarmers-market.org, from Oct. 25 to Nov. 1st. Just like last year, those items will be distributed on Nov. 7 at the Florence Middle School Parking Lot Pavilion, from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m.

This year, Just Us, a local bluegrass band, will be playing during this community event.

Berkey's Blueberries, Humble Bee Honey, and Hummingbird Wholesale are again on the list of vendors, with several new ones coming on board. Shoppers can be briefed on vendor availability by using the "bulk buying" button on the website menu bar.

When shoppers begin ordering on Oct. 25, they will find clear instructions for navigating the order process on the website's "pre-order online" menu button. The Whatsgood app will take people to the list of vendors for ordering.

on Nov. 7, with email confirmation.

This event is a thank you to a generous Florence community that has supported the Florence Farmers Tuesday Market.

According to organizers, "We began by partnering with local growers to bring healthy, organic, transitional foods, and food products, to the community at large each market day. For the past 23 weeks, the market has successfully and safely provided fresh produce, baked goods, meats, eggs, fish and prepared foods. The weekly average attendance during the peak season has been 500 shoppers."

The market is aligned with other members of the community to make food available to those in need. SNAP Double Up Bucks is a yearly staple of each market day as well as the Fill Your Pantry event. Vendors also donate remaining market items to Florence Food Share. Through the market's WLCF grant, it provides shopping scholarships for three community free lunch programs.

The Florence Farmers Market is constantly evolving with the help of market sponsors: the Western Lane Community Foundation, PeaceHealth Peace Harbor Medical Center, Shawn Fleming Construction, Re-

kindled Restorations, Lane County Master Recyclers and Shippin' Shack.

It also runs through volunteers.

On the Fill Your Pantry day, 10 volunteers per shift can direct traffic, assist vendors with their orders and make the drive-through process painless.

"We need people for three-hour shifts between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. or 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.," organizers said. "We will provide water and snacks."
