During the project, some people have expressed concerns that work completed in 2019 was either ineffective or poorly installed. That is not the case, according to Strandberg.

"The project on the Siuslaw Bridge involved replacing the deck material of the bridge lift spans. An earlier project that uses a Fiber Reinforced Polymer (FRP) process to seal the bridge deck is starting to deteriorate. The new surface is a steel grid deck, similar to what it had before the FRP repairs. State Bridge crews from Ona Beach, Astoria, Eugene, Salem and Albany assisted in the effort," said Strandberg.

The project was slated to be finished by the end of October, but Strandberg was pleased to announce on Thursday the work on the bridge is wrapping up
