

- Makes 2 dozen cookies 2 cups all-purpose flour 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 11/4 teaspoon pumpkin pie ½ teaspoon baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon baking soda 1/4 teaspoon salt
- ½ cup (8 tablespoons) unsalt-
- ed butter, room temperature 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1 egg, room temperature
- 1 cup unsweetened canned pumpkin puree
- 1 tablespoon sour cream ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/4 teaspoon almond extract (optional)
- 1 cup (16 tablespoons) unsalted butter, room temperature 1/3 cup plain Greek-style yogurt, room temperature
- 1 tablespoon milk Scant 11/2 cups confectioners sugar, plus more to taste as de-

In a medium bowl, whisk together flour, cornstarch, pumpkin pie spice, baking powder, baking soda, and salt; set aside. Add butter and sugar to bowl of stand mixer fitted with paddle attachment. Cream until light and fluffy, about 3 minutes. Add egg and mix for another minute. Add pumpkin, sour cream, vanilla and almond extracts. Mix until

ula, fold the dough once or twice so all ingredients are well combined and no flour streaks remain. Refrigerate dough for one hour up to overnight.

Prepare the frosting: In the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with paddle attachment, combine butter, yogurt, milk, and confectioners sugar. Beat until

Preheat oven to 350°. Line cookie sheet with parchment. Set it next to work area dusted with flour. Remove chilled cookie dough from refrigerator. With a medium (11/2 tablespoon) scoop, divide dough into 24 even portions, rolling each in flour to keep it from sticking. Dust off excess flour. Place as many cookie dough balls on cookie sheet, about 21/2 inches apart.

Flour the bottom of a glass and press each ball flat, to about 34" thickness. Bake for 12 minutes. Let cookies rest on cookie sheet 2 minutes. Transfer to wire rack to cool. Repeat with remaining cookie dough balls. Remove frosting from refrigerator about 10-15 minutes

Once cookies have cooled completely, frost each and cover with sprinkles. Serve immediately or store, with wax paper between each cookie. in an airtight container at room temperature for up to 3 days.


