They are giving and very loving to all they come in contact with.

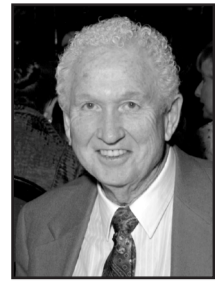

Siuslaw readies for pediatric vaccine clinic

Lane County Public Health will begin scheduling COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 5 to 11 beginning tomorrow morning through their website at lanecounty.org/vaxclinics. All pediatric vaccinations are through scheduled appointments only. There are no walk-ins at this time.

Siuslaw will be hosting a pediatric vaccine clinic on Saturday, Nov. 20, at Siuslaw Middle School, 2525 Oak St.

Registration can be made through the Lane County Public Health website. A follow-up clinic for second doses will be scheduled for three weeks later.
