On Dec. 22, Oregon State Police announced the completion of the investigation into the Sept. 20 four-vehicle crash on Highway 126 near Walton, which led to the death of Springfield resident Sarah Susman, an employee with Western Lane Ambulance District who was 25 years old.

On Dec. 22, Oregon State Police arrested Shane Tyler McVay for manslaughter 1, DUII and recklessly endangering. McVay was lodged in the Lane County Jail.

On Sept. 20 at approximately 7:14 a.m., Oregon State Troopers and emergency personnel responded to a four-vehicle crash on Highway 126 near milepost 37. Preliminary investiga-
