Of the export trade in coasters we have no exact data, as vessels thus employed are not required to report at the Custom house, and the difficulty of obtaining copy from manifests is so great that we have abandoned the hope of getting such statistics complete. However, the following summary of wheat and flour hence for San Francisco, may be deemed as reliable as any that can be had. Flour, (from Jan. 1st to September 30th, 1873), 239,304 quarter sacks. Wheat, (for same period), 114,076 centals. The Puget Sound trade, which is quite a drain upon Oregon breadstuffs, does not furnish us with any report.

We are gathering statistics of the Salmon exports from the Columbia river, which will show some interesting facts, when published.
