Post Office Notice. The General Delivery at the Astoria Postoffice will be open daily, (except Sundays), from 8 o'clock A. M. until 6 P. M.

MAILS CLOSE: For Portland and intermediate offices, at 5 1/2 o'clock A. M. daily.

For Skapanon, Seaside house, and Tillamook, daily on arrival of the mail from Portland.

For Knappont, Grays river, Klaskanine, Youngs river, Lewis and Clarke, Nehalem valley, etc., irregular.

CHANGES IN POSTAL LAWS. 1. Franking privilege abolished.

NEWSPAPER DECISIONS. 1. Any person who takes a paper regularly from the post-office—whether directed to his name or another's, or whether he has subscribed or not—is responsible for the payment.

2. If any person orders his paper discontinued, he must pay all arrearages, or the publisher may continue to send it, until payment is made, and collect the whole amount—whether the paper is taken from the office or not.

3. The courts have decided that refusing to take newspapers and periodicals from the post-office, or removing and leaving them uncollected for, is prima facie evidence of intentional fraud.
