Speech of Hon. Lafayette Lane.

We are in receipt of a copy of the speech of Hon. Lafayette Lane in the House of Representatives on the 19th ult., on the subject of the transfer of the Indian Bureau to the War Department.

"But it is urged that officers of the Army by "training, education, taste and life long habits are unfitted to enter heartily into the work of civilization by a personal interest in and supervision of the labors of teachers, missionaries, farmers and mechanics."

"How have the mighty fallen when the officers of the Army should be regarded so unworthy? "One whose training, education, taste, and life-long habits unfitted him for civilizing labors" has led the Republican party to important political victories, and to-day presides as the Chief Magistrate of the Republic.
