orchard; or to own, have or keep any herd of cattle, horses, sheep, Single Meal. making profit by the increase of product or use thereof; or to keep DARKER HOUSE, any hotel or restaurant except for the use or accomodation of Chinese setc.

Every violation of these provisions by a Chinaman is to be punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or imprisonment in the penitentiprv not exceeding six months, or both fine and imprisonment; and also by forfeiture of all property WALLA WALLA used or invested in the prohibited business.

The second section makes it unlawful for any person, corporation or company to employ any Monthe above named purposes, except as interpreters, or teachers of Chinese language, and imposes a fine of \$100 for each offense.

The United States district courts are given jurisdiction of all cases

to cover all treaty requirements:
