The secretary COUNTRY PRODUCE. holds that locators of mining claims, so long as they comply with the law governing their possession, are invested by congress with the exclusive right to the possession and enjoyment of all the surface included within the lines of their locations. This right amounts to property, and is capable of being enjoyed or transferred, subject to all ordinary rules governing the enjoyment of all other property. It may, consequently, be protected in the courts, and it is the duty of the possessor to care for his own if a trespass be attempted by strangers. 
