A New York despatch says: The extent of the Democratic victory is not yet told. Cleveland's majority in the state will reach the enormous total of a hundred and ninety thousand, utterly unprocedented in the history of the country. Counties that never went Democratic since the Republican party was organized, now have majority he has not received so many polls as Hancock had in 1880, when the latter was beaten by 21,000. The fact is, Republicans either stayed at home or voted for Cleveland. The rebuke to the administration is everywhere considered complete and terrible.

In the 38th congress the Demo crats will control the house of representatives by a majority of 71, the figures being, Republicans 227, Democrats 198. The state will be represented in the next congress by 21 Democrats and 13 Republicans, a Democratic gain of 8. The assembly will consist of 85 Democrats and 43 Republicans, thus giving the Democrats a majority of 42 in the lower house. The senate stands 17 Democrats to 17 Republicans.

THE Liverpool Shipping Telegraph, referring to the supposed line of steamers between San Francisco and Liverpool, says: "A steamship line will shortly ply between San Francisco and this port, and it is fully expected that it will divert some of the traffic of the Southern Pacific. 
