Prohibition in Politics. Nor alone in Oregon and the Northwest is the question of prohibition a living issue, but in several other states leading men testify to the importance of that question as an active element in the next two years.

In Kentucky and North Carolina, two of the largest whisky-manufacturing states, prohibition has taken a strong hold and will play an important part in future elections.

Naturally, this question is in a certain sense transferred to congress by the proposal of the whisky interest for the postponement of the internal tax on whisky.
