During the twelve months that ended last night, one hundred and thirty-six vessels cleared from the thirty-six vessels cleared from the Columbia, bound to foreign ports; in 1881, one hundred and twentysix vessels cleared; in 1880, sixtythree. This illustrates sufficiently the growth of our commerce.

173 tons that went out from the Portland Oregon Columbia in '82, total value being \$15,836,336. By way of contrast we state that the total value of Columbia river exports for '81 was \$7,655,516; the great difference illustrates the increase in our commerce during the past twelve

We present the above in condensed form for two reasons; it saves our readers the trouble of wading through a mass of figures to get at results, and it is convenient for our congressmen to clip out and incorporate in their speeches when they are demonstrating the importance of Columbia river commerce, and the necessity of Columbia bar improve-


