In an interview in San Francisco on the 11th with Charles Grocker, vice-president of the Central and Southern Pacific railroad, he stated to an Oregonian correspondent that it was proposed to expedite the construction of a Californis and Oregon railroad by every means in their power. With this end in view men are being transferred from the Mojave division on the Southern Pacific and from certain points along the Central Pacific where work has slacked up. Contracts have been let for building a large number of carts, which will be placed on the ground of operation as soon as completed. The engineer's department is exceedingly active in preparing final plans. During the coming summer much more important development will be made than during double that time previously. In a short time over 2,000 men will be put to work, and it is expected considerable progress will be


