The entire press of Ireland concurs in its approval of the result and expressing the hope that Irishmen will hereafter be deterred from the insane and criminal folly of joining such organizations. They join without any idea of their purpose, and in every instance the moving spirits have been among the first to betray their dupes. The convictions have produced a profound sensation and there seems to be a revolution of feeling with regard to the trials and their significance. The adherents of Parnell are confident that a more wholesome tone will be manifest in the public mind and a greater disposition to abide by the principles of the Irish Parliamentary party."

TEMPERANCE cannot be advanced by blending it with politics.
