Land Troubles.

EX-GOVERNOR McCook, of Colorado, now in Washington, from Mexico, says the recent decision of Secretary Teller, withdrawing lands from settlement and awarding them to the Southern Pacific, is likely to provoke border warfare. The settlers have been in possession of a large portion of the lands for many years, have erected valuable improvements, and established cattle and other ranches. In fact the effect of the decision will be to compel these people either to purchase their homes at exorbitant prices from the railroad or to secure leases. Failing in this they must abandon their homes and property, or resist being disposed. McCook states that the feeling is very bitter among these settlers, and that they will be driven to desperation, and doubtless violence, if disturbed. McCook believes that the vast inroads of railroad monopolies on the public domain will yet make serious trouble in the west, and be, at no distant day, a great political issue before the country.

All the American Archbishops, it is said, have been ordered to Rome to receive Papal instructions and make preparations for a provincial council of the whole American church, which is to be held next year at some town in the United States, not yet designated.

Several British war vessels have been ordered to re-enforce her Majesty's squadron in Chinese waters. If the prospective conquest of Tonquin by the French is to be the signal for the dismemberment of the eastern empire, England is determined to be in at the division of the spoils.

Colonel Badinet of the Cherokees says there is a job before the Indian council at Tahlequah to lease 6,000,000 acres of the best land in the territory to the Standard Oil company for five years at \$120,000 a year, with the privilege of renewal, which means a perpetual lease. The tract is valued at ten millions.

The *Prineville News* says the sales of cattle for the past week have been mainly to California buyers, I. N. Castle & Co., being the purchasers, and includes the following bands: Abe Hackleman's band of 2,400 head, beef and stock cattle at \$30 per head, and Jim Milliner's stock and beef cattle, numbering about 900 head, at \$29.

The rapid and continuous fall in recent years in the market price of silver has raised in a curious way the profit made by the mint on the silver coins which, as is well known, remain of the same weight and fineness under all variations in the intrinsic value of the metal. In 1870 the profit was only 9 per cent, in 1875 it was 16 per cent, while at present it is about 28 per cent. In one year it was even higher—namely, in 1878, when it was 31 1/2 per cent.

The Minneapolis *Tribune* says that the flouring mills of that city have a daily capacity of 37,565 barrels. Reckoning five bushels of wheat to a barrel of flour, these mills need for their daily consumption, when doing their full work 137,825 bushels of wheat—the crop say of 6,000 acres. Allowing 312 working days to the year, these mills require 43,001,400 bushels, the crop of over 2,000,000 acres of the most fertile land in the country.
