One of the most prosperous of Pennsylvania liquor dealers makes it a point to open bars where there is a strong local option law to forbid sales. He reasons that men will have liquor if they want it, and if they are obliged to get it on the sly, will not grumble at paying a high price. He carried on his trade for two years in Sharon, where the traffic was prohibited. He managed to do it, however, and got a dollar a pint for whiskey which cost him a dollar and a quarter a gallon. He often made a hundred dollars a day. Finally they arraigned him in court. He had the case postponed for six months, and went on as before. The jury disagreed, and he had six months more. The end was a fine of \$50.

During the month of June there was entered at the Yakima land office, under the timber culture law, 8,400 acres; under the pre-emption law, 7,300 acres; under the desert law, 14,400 acres, and under the homestead law, 2,037 acres. The greater part of the land included in the desert entries lies in the vicinity of the lower Columbia.
