Under date of July 25, Commissioner McFarland has issued a circular which is addressed to special agents, calling their attention to the unlawful inclosure of public lands, and directing them to promptly report the number and extent of all such cases, with the necessary corroborative evidence, that they may be transmitted to chief adjusters. The circular concludes as follows: "This department has no authority to remove fences or prosecute trespassers, and when cases have been reported to the department of justice for appropriate action the duty of this department is performed and its jurisdiction ceases."
