Fish Supply.

In the opening lecture before the Fisheries Conference, in London, Professor Huxley presented facts substantiating his statement that in fishing districts an acre of sea was more prolific in food production than an acre of land.

The Cunard Steamship company has contracted with the Clyde firm of John Eldred & Co., for two steamers of 8,000 tons for £500,000, being the largest price ever quoted.

The Oregon Short Line is now opening a region capable of supporting 5,000,000 cattle and 10,000,000 sheep.

Bessemer steel rails are selling, delivered in Chicago or Milwaukee, at \$38 a ton.

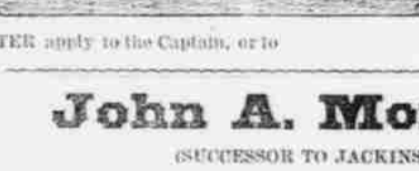
