The reception by the Czar on the 3d inst. of the new governorsgeneral of Warshaw and Turkestan, Generals Gurko, and Teheraaveff, is believed at St. Petersburg rend the inauguration of a repolicy in Poland and Central . As regards General Gurko, it is no secret that the object of his appointment is to introduce a more severe regime in Poland and to resume the work of Russification there a la Muravioff. The new Central Asian policy will, it is said, be also of a more active kind, and great efforts are being made to induce the Asiatic subjects of the czar to become the instruments of this policy. Numerous chiefs of the Turkoman, Borkharon, and Khivan tribes may be seen in the various places of amusement at St. Petersburg, accompanied by Russian officers, and most of them have been appointed to high rank in the Russian Army .- St. James


